From Oakland Area, Take Highway 580 Eastbound to Hayward and exit on the Hayward exit. Continue along Foothill Blvd for 1.5 miles, stay to the left and merge onto Mission Blvd. Turn left onto Carlos Bee Blvd, go up hill, and stay to the far right to enter the campus. At stop sign, turn left and proceed to rear of campus. Turn right at stop sign, and right into Lot K (Theatre).

# NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE, or telephoned, entries cannot be accepted. Entries
  without fees cannot be accepted. ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS or photocopies of
  entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse of the Official AKC entry forms are NOT
  ACCEPTABLE.
- CHANGES, ADDITIONS, OR CORRECTIONS to entry forms must be received IN WRITING prior to
  close of entries. Email and faxed changes are acceptable. Telephone changes are not acceptable.
  OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice,
  or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such
  entries.
- 3. An AKC RECORDING FEE of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC EVENT SERVICE FEE of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in an AKC Member or Licensed Rally Trial. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.
- 4. ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, in season, excused by the Veterinarian, or Judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee.
- 5. THE WELL-BEING OF DOĞS and participants is of paramount importance. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, floods, hurricanes, lightning, or earthquakes), or any other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refunds of entry fee(s) will be made. DO NOT LEAVE ANIMALS IN A HOT VEHICLE.
- CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY AND SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven (7) days of the show, the Trial Secretary should be contacted.
- 7. Consult Judging Program for time of judging. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club and/or its Trial Secretary will not be responsible for and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agent of class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or their agent alone are responsible for the timely presence of their dogs in the judging ring. Dogs may be excused from the trial after their class has been judged, if not eligible for further judging or awards.
- 8. THE TRIAL-GIVING CLUB, THE TRIAL SECRETARY, their agents or employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of their parents or guardians.

- 1. Overnight and Express Mail must specify "No Signature Required."
- An AKC RECORDING FEE of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC EVENT SERVICE FEE of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. An AKC Rally Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in an AKC Member or Licensed Rally Trial. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.
- ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse of the Official AKC entry forms are NOT ACCEPTABLE. CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE, or telephoned, entries cannot be accepted. Entries without fees cannot be accepted.
- 4. Please TYPE or PRINT all information on entry blanks. Use black or blue ink. OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such entries. The Club assumes no responsibility for a wrong entry.
